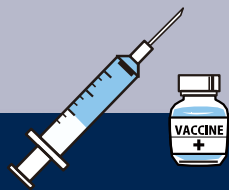


Notice About Receiving COVID-19 Vaccines



Steps to Getting Vaccinated

1 Figure out when you can get vaccinated

Vaccinations will begin with medical workers, the elderly, and those with underlying conditions in this order.

*Please wait for further announcements from the national government. You can check the Ministry of Health, Labor, and Welfare 's website or the official homepage of Gifu City.

*There is a possibility that you may have to wait longer than expected, but please understand that the national government, city, etc. have created an order for those to be vaccinated to ensure that everyone can receive one.

2 Confirm a location that you can get vaccinated at

You can check Koho Gifu (Gifu City's monthly magazine) or the Gifu City official homepage to check where you can receive the vaccine at.



*If you cannot find a place to get vaccinated, please call the call center listed at the number below.

*If you are not currently hospitalized or admitted to a facility, you can receive the vaccine in the city, town, or village that you have a certificate of residence in.

3 Make an appointment to get vaccinated

Please make a reservation with the medical institution that you would like to use or the city, town, or village that you live in.

Things to bring with you:

- Vaccination cards (enclosed forms with stickers)
- Form of ID (driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)
- Medical history form



*If you measure your temperature and find that you have a fever or otherwise feel ill before your appointment, please refrain from going and contact the medical institution or city, town, or village that you made your appointment with.

*Please come to your appointment in clothes that make it easy for the medical professional giving the vaccine to access one of your shoulders.

*In order for the vaccine to be effective, you need to get two doses of the same kind of vaccine with some time in between them. Please confirm when you can receive the second dose after getting the first dose.

*The enclosed form contains two vaccination cards and a completed vaccination certificate. Please do not cut any of these apart and make sure to bring the form with you when you receive both doses. Please fill in all necessary information on the medical history form and bring it with you too.
