## Process to getting the shot

### 1

Wait for your vaccination card/medical history form (attached together) to arrive

You can receive the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose of the COVID-19 vaccine if, in principle, at least **eight months have passed** since the day you received the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

\*Please check your vaccine certificate to confirm the date that you received the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and that at least eight months have passed since then before getting the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose.

\*If you cannot get vaccinated exactly eight months after the day you received the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose, you should wait to do so until the 1<sup>st</sup> of the next month.

\*Medical workers, those living in facilities for the elderly, etc. as well as employees of said facilities can receive the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose six months after they have received the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. Those 65 and older who are not in these groups can do so after seven months have passed from the day they received the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. Depending on the rate and number of infections, this may be changed to six months. If that happens, the city will inform everyone through Gifu City's website, Koho Gifu (the city's PR magazine), etc.

## Search for a medical institution/vaccination venue

You can use announcements made by Gifu City, Gifu City's webpage, the national government's COVID-19 Vaccine Navi (<https://v-sys.mhlw.go.jp>), etc. to find a medical institution/vaccination venue to get the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose at. For medical workers, you may be able to receive the vaccine at the medical institution you work for. Please confirm whether you can do so with your employer.

- ① Vaccination card/medical history form
- ② Vaccination certificate (This is attached to ① by a perforated line)
- ③ Document to verify your identity (Individual Number Card, driver's license, residence card, etc.)
- ④ Medicine booklet (if you have one)

\*In this notice's envelope, you should also have received a ①Vaccination card/medical history form and ②Vaccination certificate. Please store these in a safe place so you do not lose them.

(Please do not separate ① and ② when going to get vaccinated)

\*Take your temperature before going to get vaccinated, and do not go if it's clear you have a fever, are not feeling well, etc. If you cannot go to your appointment, please contact the medical institution/vaccination venue that you reserved your appointment with and let them know.

\*When going to get vaccinated, please **wear clothes that make it easy for you to quickly show either or your shoulders** to receive the vaccine in.
