## Process to getting the shot

1

Wait for your vaccination card/medical history form  
(attached together) to arriveThose eligible to receive the booster shot (4<sup>th</sup> dose) (As of M a y 25, 2022):Those that have waited five months or more since receiving the 3<sup>rd</sup> dose, as well as...

- Are 60 or older
- Are 18 or older and younger than 60 with an underlying condition or determined by a doctor to have a high risk of developing severe symptoms from COVID-19

- ① Vaccination card/medical history form (接種券一体型予診票)
- ② Vaccination certificate (予防接種済証)  
(in some cases, this may be attached to ① by a perforated line)
- ③ Document to verify your identity  
(Individual Number Card, driver's license, health insurance card, etc.)
- ④ Medicine booklet (if you have one)

\*In this notice's envelope, you should also have received a ①Vaccination card/medical history form and ②Vaccination certificate. Please store these in a safe place so you do not lose them. (Please do not separate ① and ② when going to get vaccinated.)

\*Take your temperature before going to get vaccinated, and do not go if it's clear you have a fever, are not feeling well, etc. If you cannot go to your appointment, please contact the medical institution/vaccination venue that you reserved your appointment with and let them know.

\*When going to get vaccinated, please **wear clothes that make it easy for you to quickly show either or your shoulders** to receive the vaccine in.
